Gauntlet Risk Statement

Motorcycling Quad riding and Go-Karting are inherently hazardous activities

Parents / carers and leaders of the groups coming to use the Gauntlet Project have a "duty of care" for their children / young people / group members. They should be confident that the young people concerned are physically capable of undertaking the activity **and** make Gauntlet supervisors aware of any additional needs before the session begins and ensure that young people understand the safety rules and adhere to positive behaviour whilst at the project.

All motorised vehicle riding / driving activities are potentially hazardous, both to the drivers and any spectators and it is essential that parents / carers and group leaders realise that whilst they are attending the Gauntlet Project that discipline and control of the behaviour of the young people is the responsibility of the person bringing the young people to the project. NO young person should be left unattended at the project without the person with responsibility for that young person deeming them capable of being a responsible participant. The staff and volunteers of the project cannot accept responsibility for the behaviour of individual young people and groups (this is particularly pertinent during the break times).

The project committee have set in place safety procedures for the safe use of the project including equipment, workshop and coffee bar areas, field rules and specialist equipment and it is the duty of attendees to the project to familiarise themselves with these procedures and adhere to them.

Individual organisations are strongly recommended to visit the project and undertake their own risk assessment of this activity.
